Pick-up:

Pick up is at 3:55 in the lobby of the school. Please park your car, get out of your vehicle, and form a line outside of the main doors. Once in line you will be asked who you are picking up, and students will be delivered to you. This process ensures that all students safely get to their destinations without distractions. It is important that you wait outside the lobby as after school is in session and we need to ensure every child's safety and maximize learning time without interruption. Please do not socialize or linger in the lobby as other after school events may be in session.

Bus:

Students will begin boarding the bus between 4:15 and 4:30. Due to the amount of students per bus please give the bus about 45 minutes from the time students board to make it to your child's stop.

Late Fee Policy:

Pick up is at 3:55-4:05 SHARP. Habitual lateness will result in expulsion from the program. Please call the After School phone (203) 977-4507 if you are late or if there is any change with your pick up plan.

Student Conduct:

The Enrichment Program does not have the same staff resources that are available during the school day. Unfortunately, we may not be able to adequately serve children who repeatedly require one-to-one supervision Repeated unsafe and unkind behavior may result in a student's dismissal from the Enrichment Program.

MONDAY PROGRAMS

- Sound Waters Discovery Team (Grades 3-5): Sound Waters The SoundWaters
 "Discovery Team" is hands-on and interactive and is designed to support and enhance
 learning in Stamford elementary school students. Students learn about the ecology of
 Long Island Sound. Different activities are presented to introduce students to the
 animals, habitats and watershed of the local area. Live animals, games that illustrate
 scientific concepts, related crafts, and simple experiments are among the types of
 activities included.
- Lion Leaders (Grades 1-4): Miss Ackerman and Miss Kane- Lion Leaders is a club
 that focuses on bringing out our best selves. Students will be challenged to be a leader.
 As a group, students will think about how to create a more positive community within our
 school. They will work on projects and implement ideas within the building to promote
 kindness and leadership to inspire others.
- Stillmeadow Community Singers (Grades 2-5): Mr. Bodofsky- The "Stillmeadow Community Singers" is a vocal ensemble consisting of students from second to fifth grades. The purpose of the group is to learn more about proper vocal technique, experience music they may have never heard before and see how it can relate to their everyday lives and even other school studies and of course to have a lot of fun while learning. The ensemble has been invited to sing at corporate parties, for the Board of Education, tree lightings, the Stamford Town Center and even the Bridgeport Sound Tigers and Blue Fish Games.
- Gym Kidz (Grades K-2): The Gym Guyz- GYMKIDZ is an exercise based enrichment
 program. It is a structured and progressive series of developmentally age and grade appropriate
 activities that include games, relays, sport specific and obstacle course challenges. Our GYMKIDZ
 program is designed to facilitate an atmosphere that encourages teamwork, comradery and
 confidence.
- Game Club (Grades K-3) Ms. Cerbone: This club focuses on having an enjoyable, entertaining time without having an electronic device in your hands. Students will learn to play and create board games while working on skills that encourage teamwork, patience, critical thinking and reasoning.
- Forensic Detectives (Grades 3-5): Stamford Museum & Nature Center- Discover the
 basics of how detectives solve human and animal crimes as we investigate different
 types of evidence that can be left behind. Learn how to ID fingerprints or hair samples,
 test pens for ink samples, or match a shoe to its print. Learn how conservationists use
 animal bones, scat, tracks and other artifacts to protect endangered plants and animals
 around the world.

TUESDAY PROGRAMS

- Math Club (Grades 3-5): Mrs. Jones-McDowell- Fun, hands-on math activities that
 activate your problem solving skills. You apply your math learning to real-life scenarios
 Students will go in depth planning, problem solving and demonstrating their knowledge.
 Students will also build on math fluency and automaticity through interactive games
- Readers Theater (Grade 2): Miss Rigakos Students will bring their reading skills to life
 using various Reader's Theater scripts including *The Very Cranky Bear, The Three Billy*Goats Gruff, Moose's Loose Tooth, etc.. With each script students will practice reading
 scripts fluently, will work on comprehension of stories, engage in social interactions,
 perform, create, and practice public speaking skills. In addition, students will create
 scenery and props for each script.
- LEGO Works (Grades K-1): Miss Balch- LEGO Works is a hands-on program that builds teamwork, critical thinking and creative skills among students. Children work together in small groups to design and build structures reflecting a different project each week (e.g. animal habitats, communities, medieval castles, etc.) Beyond creative play, this program develops students' problem solving, presentation, and helps students gain a sense of accomplishment and builds confidence.
- Dance Your Heart Out (K-5): Ms. Romanello & Ms. Evarts: Students will learn a
 combination of different styles of dance. Each class will start with a warm up, stretching,
 and end with a choreographed routine that will be performed during a school assembly.
 This class is perfect for all students. Modifications will be made based on student dance
 experience.
- After School Homework Club (Grade 5): Mr. Zaremski- Students will have an
 opportunity to get help with their homework, learn about study skills to help them
 succeed and/or a quiet place to do their homework.
