4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from commercially applying fertilizer to certain property unless the person is a professional fertilizer applicator or employs a 5 6 professional fertilizer applicator; requiring a person that employs a certain 7 professional fertilizer applicator to obtain a certain license for each place of business 8 for which the professional fertilizer applicator provides certain services requiring 9 each place of business at which a person is employed to apply fertilizer to certain 10 property used for nonagricultural purposes to have a certain certified professional fertilizer applicator on staff and be licensed annually by the Department of 11 Agriculture; requiring an applicant for a certain license to submit a certain 12 application and pay a certain fee to the Department; altering the application of a 13 certain civil penalty to include the employer of a person who violates certain 14 15 provisions of law; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to professional fertilizer applicators nonagricultural fertilizer application. 16


