Your patients use Cost Estimator to predict out-of-pocket costs for procedures and prescriptions.



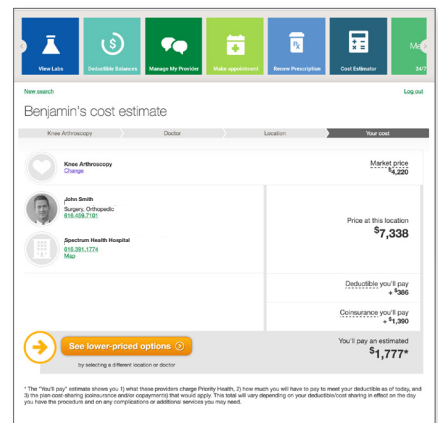
Now, you can use Cost Estimator on behalf of your patients at priorityhealth.com/provider.

- The tool combines provider and facility pricing with a member's benefit and deductible balance to calculate their anticipated out-of-pocket costs. *The member may have an opportunity to save money by choosing a different provider and facility combination.*
- Estimated out-of-pocket costs are based on our contracted rates.
- Cost Estimator continues to be updated with common procedures including the most frequently billed CPTs.
- Cost Estimator displays facility locations where the services are available to members and have been billed to Priority Health within the last nine months, including hospitals, ambulatory surgical centers, free standing clinics, and specialty and primary care provider (PCP) offices.

Rx costs are the #1 searched items. Members can now use the tool to find prescription drug costs by pharmacy, based on their plan benefits.


As a valued provider, you can help in three ways:

Using Cost Estimator

1 After logging in at priorityhealth.com/provider and clicking the calculator icon, you'll need to look up your patient by entering their contract number or first and last name.


